

Marylebone Boys' School home-school agreement

To reinforce the partnership between home and school, students, parents/carers and the school will sign a home-agreement. The agreement will be valid for the duration of study at MBS.

On behalf of the school, teachers will make a commitment that the school will:

- Provide a safe, trusting and stimulating environment for your son.
- Do its best to ensure that your son fulfils his potential as a learner and as a member of the school community.
- Offer a broad and balanced curriculum to students of all abilities.
- Encourage all students to take responsibility for their own actions, feel proud of their achievements and enjoy being a student at the school.
- Assess students' work and provide regular targets/guidance on how to improve.
- Keep you informed about your son's progress and general school matters.
- Insist that all students observe the school's behaviour and anti-bullying policies.
- Set and mark regular homework and provide a suitable environment for homework to be completed at school.

Students agree that they will:

- Attend school regularly and arrive punctually and ensure our 3P core values (Professionalism, Productively, Positivity) are embraced everyday.
- Wear their uniform correctly and bring the correct equipment each day.
- Work hard to achieve and surpass their targets.
- Help other students by allowing each teacher to teach and every learner to learn.
- Conduct themselves well in and out of class, to and from school, with students and staff, in accordance with the school code of conduct.
- Respect and care for others and their property (including school property).
- Meet all deadlines for handing in homework.
- Participate fully and positively in all lessons, private study, enrichment and learning opportunities offered by the school.
- Pass all letters, notes and reports to parents on the day they are issued.
- Talk with parents and teachers about their concerns in school.

With a focus on support and communication, parents/carers agree they will:

- Take an active interest in all aspects of their son's school life.
- See that their son attends school regularly, on time, and properly equipped.
- Communicate to school all relevant information that may affect their son's work or behaviour.
- Notify the school if, for any reason, their child cannot attend.
- Encourage their child to follow the school's behaviour policy and support associated action taken by the school.
- Support the school's extended school day.
- Provide suitable facilities at home to engage learning and encourage their child to make every effort to succeed.
- Do their best to attend parents' meetings and other meetings at which their presence is requested.
- Inform school of any changes to the home address for the student.
- Inform school immediately of any changes to the telephone number, email address and home address of the people listed as contact persons for the student.
